

How to Use the Database

You can download this database to your computer for your own use. Some information on retrieving information has been provided.

This database has been opened with Internet Explorer 7.0, Firefox 2.0.0.11, and Opera 9.24. It could **not** be accessed with Netscape 7.1.

To Retrieve Information:

- Download the database (4.2 MB Microsoft Access file). Double click to start.
- When it opens the “Start Form” will appear.
- The scientific and common names of a plant appear in the boxes at the top.
- A data navigation bar appears at the bottom of the form, labeled “Record” at the left edge. Clicking on the right arrow takes you through the species list in alphabetical order by scientific name. Clicking on the left arrow takes you back.
- Once you find the species you want to look at, click on one of the buttons; for example, “Life Form.” A life form dialogue box displays, with the life form information along with the citation number in a drop-down list box.
 - Next to the drop-down list box is a search button (binoculars icon).
 - Clicking on the search button brings up the citation display. The drop-down list box allows you to select the citation you want.
 - However, a glitch in the program prevents the binoculars button from always working correctly, so if the dropdown box to the right appears empty, or if you get an error message, click on the arrow on the right side of the dropdown box and the citation number will appear there.
