Responses were varied and comments were generally neither entirely negative nor positive but provided constructive criticism. Recommendations included having the breakout sessions immediately following the sessions, selecting more experienced moderators, having an expert panel instead of breakout sessions, or structuring them differently. Some were pleased with the outline for the sessions and the skilled moderators.
